

## Local Rules

The following local rules shall apply in addition to any supplementary or temporary local rules displayed by the Committee.

- 1) **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)**
  - a) Beyond any fence, wall, hedge, or line of white posts marking the boundary of the course.
  - b) On or over the road parallel to the right of the 1st hole.
  - c) Practice area to the right of the 1st hole as defined by the line of white stakes.
  - d) Over the wall surrounding the car park.
  - e) Over the He-Ha in front of the Clubhouse.
- 2) **WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**

Definition: A water hazard is any sea, lake, pond, river, ditch, surface drainage ditch or other open water course (whether containing water or not) and anything of a similar nature on the course.

  - a) Any unmarked ditches to be treated as lateral water hazards.
  - b) If a ball comes to rest in the water hazard (lake) on holes 16 & 18, having last crossed a yellow line, a ball may be dropped under the provisions of Rule 26, or, as an additional option, in the nearest available Dropping Zone, under penalty of one stroke.
- 3) **GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25)**
  - a) All areas appropriately marked by the Course Manager.
  - b) Tractor or vehicle ruts but not shallow indentations.
  - c) Newly laid drainage channels.
  - d) Re-seeded and re-turfed areas, with the exception of seeded divots.
  - e) Area of newly prepared ground surrounding the base of protected trees.
- 4) **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)**
  - a) Artificially surfaced roads and paths.
  - b) Sprinkler heads and covers.
  - c) Staked and wired trees.
  - d) Decorative barked area at the base of some trees as defined by the cultivated area.
  - e) The earth basins around the newly planted trees.
  - f) Stone filled drainage ditches around the 1st, 2nd and 3rd holes.
- 5) **MOVABLE OBSTRUCTION (Rule 24-1)**
  - a) 150 yard marker post bases.
  - b) Stones in bunkers.
  - c) 150 yard marker posts.
- 6) **INFORMATION**
  - a) All distance markers are measured to the centre of the green.
  - b) Rakes should be placed with the head of the rake in the bunker and the handle outside.
  - c) Players should be aware of a Public Right of Way extending across the 15th Fairway and down the right hand side of the Practice Ground.
